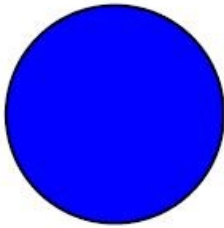
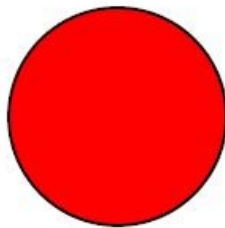


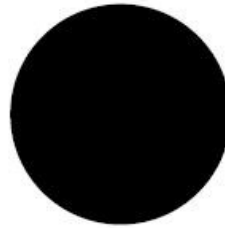
PRIMARY BALLS



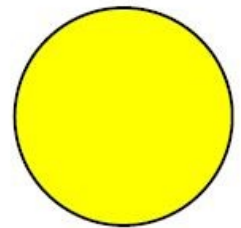

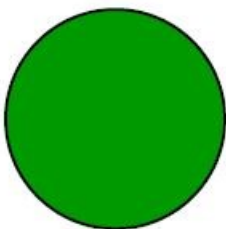

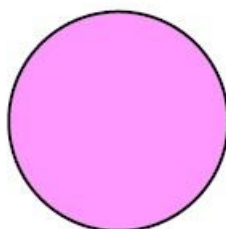

Blue and Black partner each other (think of them as the darker colours or think of being “Black & Blue”), while Red and Yellow (think of them as the lighter, brighter or fiery colours) partner each other. In general, balls are always played in this sequence.

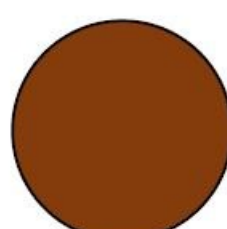
SECONDARY BALLS



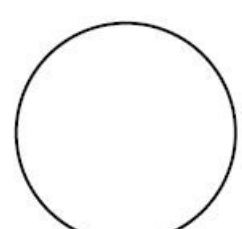
GREEN

Green and Brown partner each other (the darker colours), while Pink and White (the lighter, colours) partner each other. The mnemonic “Spring, Summer, Autumn, Winter” may be a useful way of remembering the sequence.

Sadly, no-one has ever thought of an equally useful mnemonic for the Primary Balls!
